# COVID-19 Vaccine Mandates

**H**ello everyone, I hope this message finds you and your family well. As you go to work each day, remember that the RSA is always here when needed. However, if we don't know you need us, we can't help you, so don't hesitate to contact us.

## COVID-19 VACCINE

One issue the RSA is ready to take a stand on is mandated vaccinations. While this battle will be difficult, it is the proper battle to fight. In my opinion, if people were to follow the rule of law, this would not be an issue, and there would be no battle to fight. Understandably, some people have questions about vaccines, because there is a lot of conflicting information out there. I also appreciate that people have varying reasons for not getting vaccinated. Unfortunately, it appears that many people with authority are making decisions on mandated vaccines based on their personal beliefs. While we await a future announcement on vaccines, we will follow the law and work with the County to ensure we can keep people at work, allowing us to fulfill our mission and keep this County's residents safe.

The Department will soon be following State mandates and will ask department members to take the COVID-19 vaccination. The department members will also be asked to state their vaccination status privately and securely. If you exercise your right not to take the vaccination or state your status, you will have to provide a medical or religious waiver and be treated as if you are unvaccinated.

RSA has been monitoring this issue and legal decisions regarding

so long as they offer reasonable accommodations to people who refuse the vaccine because of a disability or religious belief covered by the Americans with Disabilities Act or Title VII of the Civil Rights Act. Employers must also comply with laws ensuring a safe workplace

The Justice Department's Office of Legal Counsel issued an opinion that said it is legal to require vaccinations that are distributed with an emergency-use authorization; the

employers mandating vaccines. We have consulted with labor and employment lawyers and spoken with other POA's and have learned that legally there is little preventing private or public employers from imposing vaccination requirements.

The Equal Employment Opportunity Commission, an authority for both public and private employers, has issued guidance that employers could require employee vaccinations,

three mainstream Covid-19 vaccines received EUAs and aren't yet fully approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration. Having emergency status, the opinion said, “does not prohibit public or private entities from imposing vaccination requirements, even when the only vaccines available are those authorized under [emergency-use approval].”

### EXEMPTIONS

As Sheriff Bianco stated in his email to the Department, there are two exemptions for those who choose not to get vaccinated. One, a medical waiver which requires a signed note from a health care provider. Two, a religious waiver signed by the employee. The religious waiver needs to state the following: "I am opting out of receiving the COVID-19 vaccination because of my sincerely held religious beliefs." A sincerely held religious belief is a belief that can be either theistic, or a moral and/or ethical belief as to what is right and wrong, but both are acceptable if they are sincerely held.

If you elect to take one of the two options that do not include getting vaccinated, please be ready to get tested regularly. We have met and conferred with the County on this issue and have ensured the testing will be done on duty and at the County's expense. Although, this is not a perfect resolution, we believe that given the current pandemic situation, it's a fair and reasonable agreement that will help keep everyone safer.

Members have asked if I think there will ever be a time where we are forced to receive the vaccination. My response is that it likely depends on the California Gubernatorial Re-Call Election on September 14, 2021. I have heard rumors in the political world that if Governor Newsom is successful and remains in office, he plans to force the vaccine on all people who work for places that receive money from the State of California. The Riverside County Sheriff's Department receives State money and, therefore, would have to require it.

If that situation comes to pass, RSA will do everything we can to fight mandated vaccinations and at least keep the waiver options available. If we are unsuccessful, the decision will then fall on each individual and their own personal beliefs. I do not intend to alarm members, but am just providing my thought to a question that is asked often.

Lastly, this is directed to our over sixty Members who live in the northern part of Moreno Valley, District Two. **T**he Public Safety Unit (PSU) has been an affiliate member of the Riverside Sheriff's Association (RSA) for about twenty years; and for nearly as long, staff have asked why we are not full members. We finally have an opportunity to become full members and some staff are asking, "why now and why pay more?" The answer is simple, it benefits us and the association.

More specifically, it benefits us with voting rights, the ability to serve on the executive board, future possibility to enter RSA's benefits trust, etc. It also benefits RSA by collecting full dues instead of half. We have been receiving nearly all the benefits at half the cost. With the current assault on law enforcement, including defund efforts, the association needs all its member's support now more than ever; and

not just morale or political support, RSA also needs our financial support.

I realize, in our last contract, we didn't get the full raises we hoped for and many staff took substantial hits with the rise in their insurance premiums (I was one of them). However, we can't be selfish and think short term. That short sightedness is what has allowed the Department to push us around for so many years.

Under RSA's guidance we have seen improvements and this is simply the next step in obtaining more. We must unite behind RSA and pay our fair share. If we are able to enter RSA's benefits trust, most staff will see cost savings, assuming they select reasonable medical coverage, not a Cadillac plan.

When the survey is released, please vote to join RSA as full members. Don't get hung up on the short term cost, instead, look at it as a long term strategy to strengthen the association, and eventually gain access to their benefits trust. I liken a no vote to stepping over dollars to pick up pennies.

**W**hen romance dies it does not end responsibilities to each other and your children.


Dissolved families not only leave a bitter future for a divided family, there is an exceptional cost to the feelings of the severed partners. Success anywhere is not worth failure in the home. We run into a spiritual problem as well as a legal one.

“Whoever GOD has joined together let not anyone put asunder!” Know the difference between a covenant marriage and a contractual joinder. The contract marriage is formed on paper by judges, mayor, high government officials, and quasi spiritual leaders. You can tear up a contract. 



# A Year For The Record Books

The state has faced many challenges this year, keeping the legislature busy

The legislature returned to Sacramento on August 16<sup>th</sup> to close out the first half of the 2021-2022 session. Prior to adjournment on September 10<sup>th</sup>, the hundreds of remaining bills will be killed or sent to the governor's desk in anticipation of enactment.

This year is certainly one for the record books. Our state has suffered significantly this year due to a number of factors that have kept the legislature extremely busy. These challenges include COVID-19 and its variants, mask and vaccine mandates, schools struggling to reopen, an economy trying to return to full strength, historic drought, an increasing wildfire season and the looming, second-ever recall election of the governor.

With these crises consuming the Capitol, it has been a challenge for legislators to significantly engage in a meaningful way on the important public safety issues of importance to law enforcement professionals throughout the state. The next four

weeks will be critical as the legislature determines the fate of these bills.

## UPCOMING DEADLINES

**AUG. 27** Last day for fiscal committees to meet and pass bills. Bills that are not passed by the fiscal committees remain dead for the year.

**AUG. 30 - SEPT. 10** Floor session only. No committee may meet for any purpose except Rules Committee, bills referred pursuant to A.R. 77.2, and Conference Committee bills. This essentially means no committee hearings will be held to amend bills that have otherwise died. Unless the Legislature wants to, which is why the exception is noted.

**SEPT. 3** Last day to amend bills on the floor. Unlike other deadlines, the California Constitution requires that all bills be “in print” for three days prior to a final vote. As such,

there are no exceptions and this rule may not be waived.

**SEPT. 4-5** Weekend. No legislative session held.

**SEPT. 6** Labor Day. No legislative session held.

**SEPT. 10** Last day for any bill to be passed. Interim Recess begins upon adjournment

**SEPT. 14** Election Day - Recall of Governor

**OCT. 10** Last day for the Governor to sign or veto bills that were passed by the Legislature before September 10 and were in the Governor's possession on or after September 10

Note: If a new governor is sworn in before all of the bills are dispensed with, the new governor would be empowered to sign or veto them. This is unlike the 2003 election when Gov. Gray Davis was recalled. That election took place *after* the deadline passed to either sign or veto legislation on his desk.

### SIGNIFICANT BILLS REMAINING

The major bills affecting law enforcement and public safety that remain for this year include:

SB 81 - effectively eliminates many sentence enhancements and is retroactive

SB 98 - allows non-reporters to cross and re-cross police lines during protests and riots

SB 262 - another effort to abolish cash bail for criminals

SB 284 - expands PTSD presumptions to additional groups of peace officers

SB 299 - allows felons to receive victims comp assistance if injured by police

SB 519 - decriminalizes ecstasy, mushrooms, LSD, mescaline/peyote, etc

SB 710 - seeks to prevent POAs/DSAs from contributing to DA campaigns

AB 26 - duty to intervene if another officer is using excessive force

AB 48 - eliminates/restricts use of less-lethal tools against dangerous crowds

AB 124 - reduced sentencing for violent criminals who claim childhood/other trauma

AB 333 - eliminates application of gang enhancements by creating new restrictions

AB 481 - limits ability of law enforcement to purchase federal surplus equipment

AB 490 - bans use of restraints that may lead to positional asphyxia

AB 506 - requires background checks for omitted child/youth workers

AB 937 - upends deal on "sanctuary state" allowing more criminals to avoid deportation

AB 990 - creates a "right" to jail/prison visits, regardless of inmate/visitor behavior

Your legislative team and leadership will be focused on these and a handful of other bills as this session winds down. We will then begin to prepare for another onslaught of bills that are expected to further target law enforcement and public safety in 2022.



# Opioid Medically-Correct Cutback, Cutoff, Or Continuation

There are injuries and medical conditions of such a significant degree that the only methodology available at one time was thought to be the usage of opioids to mitigate or minimize the pain and discomfort emanating from injury or condition. As a result, opioid medication became a vehicle to deal with these problems for many years.

Eventually, however, it was learned that opioid medications can lead to dysfunction and other medical issues.

Once this became apparent, subsequent

studies did additional reviews regarding the usage of opioids. Medical providers, insurance carriers and adjusters therefore responded by denying this form of treatment. This blanket approach then brought to life not only the possible risk of taking opioids, but also the great risk and harm of improperly reducing or weaning people off these medications.

On 8/3/21, the University of California at Davis issued a study which examined some of the templates used to decrease opioid medication and determined that the pain management methodology of the medication and the cutback or complete removal of same in certain situations increases the risk of mental health issues, such as suicidal ideation which in some cases leads to actual suicide. In some cases, individuals who have used opioids have done so because the practitioner prescribing the medication has not considered the full

range of non-opioid options designed to increase an individual's functionality with-

out the use of opioids, and in other cases opioids are the only possible method of care.

The cutback on the usage of opioid medications has very much

impacted the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. While they have a focus on the dangers of opioids, they have not fully examined the dangers of ceasing or cutting back on the medication if it is not done in a proper medical manner.

Even though opioids can have a strong negative impact, some patients actually benefit from such usage. The long-term risk of using this form of treatment is indeed present; but there is also a high level of risk with

-- first, the addictive nature of opioids and their side-effects; and secondly, the necessity of following the proper protocol issued by the U.S. Food & Drug Administration when weaning long-term patients off these drugs or cutting back their usage. The University of California at Davis study specifically addresses this subject, stating that a gradual reduction in opiate doses is required, coupled with careful patient monitoring. This clearly reflects that getting off opioids

opioids. Such matters are currently being reviewed by Utilization Review doctors, and there is no requirement for these doctors to have the same credentials and understanding as the patient's treater. Utilization Review doctors can increase their revenue by engaging in a "catch-and-release program" -- quickly reviewing and not seeing the patient and issuing their opinion so they can then move on to the next patient's records. Of significance is the fact that a UR doctor's

inappropriate cessation or reduction of opioid intake when the proper template for weaning is not followed. Some patients whose opioid usage is cut off in a rapid manner experience "overdose withdrawals", characterized by a high level of anxiety and depression and, in some cases, suicide attempts which result in actual suicide.

The study issued by the University of California at Davis addresses the risk, reality and potential impact of overdose withdrawals and attempts to curtail or cut back opioid usage.

Therefore, it is imperative that doctors prescribing opioids recognize at least the following two aspects

is not simply a matter of curtailing them. Instead, what is necessary is a medical plan designed according to the specific needs of the specific patient based on the specific problems the patient has. If there is a reduction protocol, the methodology utilized should be designed to minimize or remove the patient's risk of facing additional medical problems, suicidal ideation, and/or depression.

This is a reflection of the inadequacies of the current protocol in the Workers' Compensation system with regard to setting forth a request for authorization of opioid medication or a reduction protocol for the use of

opinion is not an opinion of substance because their interaction with all patients is on a one-time basis of record review -- again, not seeing the patient. It is not day-to-day, week-to-week, month-to-month or year-to-year. Therefore, they never have the opportunity to really know the patient, which is a clear disadvantage.

The reduction program is complex and needs to be individually designed for each patient. If the Utilization Review doctor (who, once again, does not see the patient) curtails or precludes certain treatment -- such as the medication or its extent of usage, and this is harmful to the patient -- the

right to appeal, as the parties know, is restricted to Independent Medical Review (IMR). However, IMR doctors also never see the patient; therefore, as is the case with UR doctors, the opinions of IMR doctors lack substance because of their lack of familiarity with the injured workers for whom they are making important medical decisions.

Unfortunately, when it comes to UR and IMR doctors and their opinions, there are no checks and balances. As medical professionals, they have the responsibility to make appropriate decisions. If they fail to do so because of a lack of education, poor judgment or a catch-and-release program, they cannot be subject to medical malpractice.

In the Law1199.com newsletter 2019 Issue #10, there is a review of the King v. CompPartners case, which found the UR/IMR doctors not liable for their medical malpractice. In the King case, Supreme Court Justice Goodwin H. Liu, after reviewing this subject in great depth, made this finding: "But the undisputed facts in this case suggest that the workers' compensation system, and the utilization review process in particular, may not be working as the Legislature intended." Justice Goodwin H. Liu reflected: "The Legislature may wish to examine whether the existing safeguards provide sufficient incentives for competent and careful Utilization Review."

The recent study and the concern regarding opioid addiction and complications reflects the ongoing

changes which continue to occur in the medical world. Therefore, a protocol which might have been embraced in 2010 may have been modified in 2015, and again in 2020. Each modification is dependent upon the uniqueness of each patient and new medical studies.

Unfortunately, there will be a continuation of workers who sustain serious injuries necessitating a high level of care through medication, surgery, physical therapy and other modalities. The current opioid side-effects are there, but the path to make the changes needed must be based on medical probability and reflect the current state of the art in medicine based on recent studies, such as the one submitted by the University of California at Davis on 8/3/21. ★
