Overhauling The Workers' Comp System

Focusing On A Member-Centered Workers' Compensation Experience

orkers' compensation will be needed in every member's career. Unfortu-



nately, navigating the workers' compensation system has not always been easy. Significant issues have been with delayed (or non-existent) treatment, frustration with missed work, and career uncertainty.

For several years RSA aimed at tackling the "workers' comp problem" through a negotiated process with the County. Specifically, RSA looked to enter into an "Alternative Dispute Resolution system" (aka ADR) where a member could efficiently secure competent medical treatment focusing on returning to work as soon as safely possible. In this process, RSA insisted upon premier-level immediate care facilities with a comprehensive list of pre-authorized treatments so that a member could confidently seek direct medical care without concern for administrative delays. Further, should a disagreement arise between a member and the County, there needs to be a legal structure to provide efficient and impartial dispute resolution so that a member's concerns will be heard, and a fair resolution reached.

I am excited to announce that the Department of Industrial Relations has approved our proposed ADR between RSA members and the County, and the program went "live" earlier this month! To help carry out our initial vision of a member-centered workers' compensation experience, RSA has established an RSA Wellness Unit to serve as a handson resource for injured members during their workers' compensation claim.

WHO DOES THE ADR APPLY TO?

As of now, all reports of injuries for active members of the Law Enforcement Unit and Corrections Unit will be processed through the ADR system. Should you have an existing workers' compensation claim, you may opt-in to the ADR system by notification

and agreement with the County. RSA retired members claiming presumptive injuries under Labor Code 3212 and 3213 may be included in this ADR.

HOW IS THIS DIFFERENT THAN BEFORE?

Until now, when an RSA member suffered an injury, all treatment would be subject to review and approval before such treatment could occur. Now, short of surgical intervention and more involved medical treatment, the injured worker has immediate access to care by their physician. For example, a treating doctor has direct authorization to order an x-ray, MRI, or CT scan and orders for physical therapy, chiropractic therapy, or specialist consultations (Please visit the RSA website for a comprehensive list of pre-authorized care.)



Previously, when a workers' compensation dispute arose, an injured member did not have access to an ADR, meaning their claim would proceed through the workers' compensation process as defined by the California Labor Code. This means claims would be filed at the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board and subject to the extended time delays and periods for specific discovery and medical examination. Should a dispute arise, a member is now entitled to an expedited discovery process, including an evaluation with an Independent Medical Evaluator (aka IME) within thirty days. Also, IME's are now required to issue reporting quickly.

WHY DOES ADR MATTER?

To expedite competent medical care, a member is assured their treatment is taken seriously by a trustworthy medical provider. This level of care far exceeds prior expectations and gives a member certainty about their return to work safely and sensibly.

Should there be a dispute, a member now has immediate access to an expedited system to resolve all issues without delays inherent in the existing workers' compensation system. Again, our goal is expediting the concerns of our members in a manner aimed at a quick and fair resolution.

WHAT IS THE RSA WELLNESS UNIT, AND HOW WILL IT HELP ME?

The RSA Wellness Unit exists to serve RSA members as a resource through the ADR process. A member will have access to a dedicated RSA wellness representative to provide detail and resources regarding the ADR, including available medical facilities, authorized treatment, dispute information, and support throughout the ADR process. The RSA Wellness unit is intended to provide reliable, member-focused support for an injury.

Stay safe out there and prioritize the well-being of both you and your partners to ensure a safe return home for everyone. *








than ever; and not just morale or political support, RSA also



They're Baaaaack...

Staying On Guard For 'Gut-And-Amend' Bills

hroughout the summer recess, we've been meeting with legislators



and their staff, educating them about our concerns regarding the top dozen or so bills remaining that pose a threat to peace officer and/or public safety.

More than 2600 bills were introduced in 2023, over the past eight months the legislative process has whittled that down to about 900 bills. Those now await action via the Appropriations Committees of the Senate and Assembly.

Nearly all of these bills will be sent to the "suspense file" and their fate will be decided when each Appropriations Committee announces its passage or defeat, which is expected to occur on September 1. After that, all bills must be approved by the legislature before they adjourn for the rest of the year by September 15.

While most bills will survive the committees' action and become eligible for a floor vote during the final weeks of session, some bills will be held in committee, killing them for the rest of the year. Still others will be amended in an effort to secure sufficient votes for passage on the floor.

A small number of bills will be significantly altered before they are approved, via a process known as "gut-and-amend." This is where the entire contents of a bill are stripped out (gutted) and replaced with completely new language (amended).

Importantly, a small number of bills will be significantly altered before they are approved, via a process known as "gut-and-amend." This is where the entire contents of a bill are stripped out (gutted) and replaced with completely new language (amended).

Gut-and-amends are frequently sought by lawmakers when an issue of urgent importance arises after the bill introduction deadline has passed. However, some legislators use this procedural exception to revive a bill that was previously defeated. In those cases, legislators gut one of their bills that advanced to the other house and insert the language of one of their other bills that died earlier in the session.

So as we continue to advocate for and against the bills that have survived to this point in the year, we have to remain vigilant for these gut and amends that can pop up at any time prior to the final week of session. The following bills are our top remaining priorities to amend or defeat:

AB 280 (Holden) bans solitary housing for violent, vulnerable inmates (vetoed last session)

AB 505 (Ting) inexperienced, duplicative oversight of juvenile facilities

AB 733 (M. Fong) prohibits peace officers from purchasing their service firearms

AB 958 (Santiago) mandates inmate visits, regardless of violent behavior (vetoed last session)

AB 994 (Jackson) requires law enforcement to post known, false info about criminal suspects

AB 1028 (McKinnor) eliminates mandated reporting of domestic violence



AB 1310 (McKinnor) early release of inmates convicted of using firearms in crimes

AB 1486 (Jones-Sawyer) regular law enforcement rifle purchases subjected to public approval

AB 1584 (Weber) prosecution barred from seeking jury trial on defendant's competence

SB 2 (Portantino) prevents some peace officers from carrying a firearm off-duty for protection

SB 50 (Bradford) prohibits officers from enforcing safety-related traffic laws

SB 58 (Wiener) decriminalizes psychedelics for recreational (not just medical) use for adults

SB 94 (Cortese) allows release of torture/killers sentenced to life in prison after just 25 years

SB 377 (**Skinner**) bans peace officers from buying/using best available firearms on duty

SB 519 (Atkins) violates peace officers' rights, making investigative records public


